This forum is an opportunity for friends, colleagues, social service providers and the general public to discuss and learn about the late Senator Wynona M. Lipman (1923-1999), her family life and her legislative accomplishments.

Senator Lipman was New Jersey's first African-American woman Senator, who served 27 years in the State Senate and worked tirelessly to improve the health and well-being of women, children, and underserved populations throughout the State of New Jersey, particularly in the 29th district. Senator Lipman fought for women and family empowerment, equitable compensation for women and helped to enact the Domestic Violence Act of 1981 and Fair Housing Act of 1985. She fought against employment discrimination, sexual assault, gender inequality and antiquated marriage laws.
